POINT ISABEL CEMETERY

The earliest settlement in Green Township was in 1843. The first church was built by the Methodists on the Jeremiah Hammer farm. He donating the ground for church and graveyard purposes. The first church was built of logs, as time passed and a small town was begun at the cross - roads a mile east, a new church was built at that place. The cemetery has a full population and only an occasional burial is made there. Lovely tall pine trees stand in this place and old fashioned roses ramble over the graves of these early makers of a fine township.

This is what the DAR wrote in the 1940's.

This cemetery is located exactly one half mile west of the intersection of State Road #13 and State Road #26, on the north side of State Road #26

I worked in this cemetery in June of 1996. I was appalled at the number of stones missing. Row after row of bases protruding out of the ground attest to the fact of the missing stones. In several places there were many stones stacked together. On the west end, near the highway, is an above ground crypt - like structure, which was full of stones. Many were in pieces and several were footstones and just miscellaneous parts of bases. I wonder if this was actually built to hold what was left of the Kelly - McClain Cemetery. They say it was destroyed by logs. When the DAR read the cemeteries in the early 1940's, it was mentioned that all that was found at the Kelley - McClain was one piece of a stone. Is it possible that they were moved long before the DAR read the cemeteries?

Old fashioned roses are still abundant in this cemetery, but only one fir tree still stands. Many of the stones were illegible from time and the elements. I found many stones that the DAR had not recorded in the 1940's, but there are still 30 stones I didn't find that they had recorded. This doesn't mean they aren't there. Many stones were beyond recognition. I would guess there were at least a dozen stones I couldn't get any information from. There is also the possibility I could have missed some, as careful as I tried to be sometimes it does get difficult. There were at least two thickets that were grown up so bad, it was hard to tell if I got all the stones.

NOTE: It has been brought to my attention that the 1877 Atlas of Grant County designates the name of this cemetery as New Hope. I have no explanation for this. Their was another cemetery called New Hope/Faxton, located on 38th St. southeast of Marlon. That cemetery is almost totally destroyed leaving only 3 markers left. I have no idea whether there are any connections here or not.

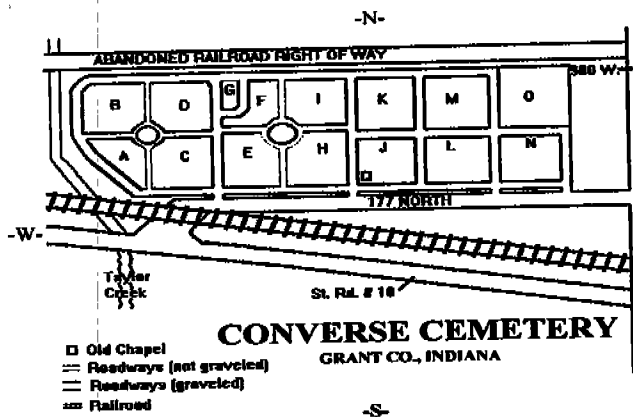

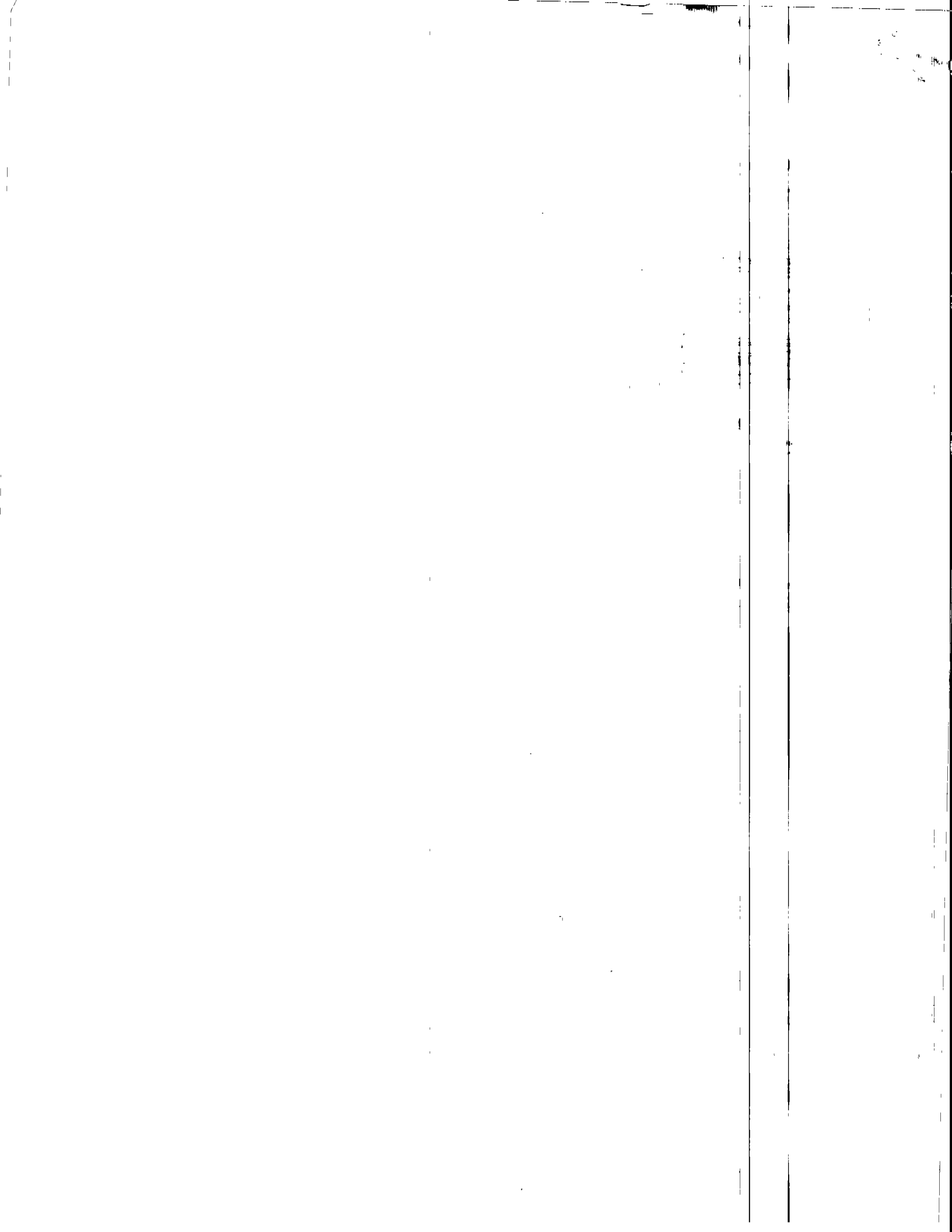

The cemetery in Richland township of Grant County Indiana is owned by the Od Fellow Lodge of Converse and is called the Converse Cemetery. It was laid out in 19 a history of Miami County says on page 318 "in 1872 a cemetery costing \$2000 was lai out near the town."

The present cemetery has had bodies reinterred in it after having been remov from a small family cemetery which was located in the heart of what is now Converse from a family cemetery a short distance south called the Pence Cemetery. Referring histories of these two counties I find some items of interest. The old Atlas of 187 William Taylor settled the Martin Pence farm where the Delphi road crosses Taylor Creek at an early day. A child of his was the first buried in the Pence Graveyard. plot is located on a knoll overlooking the creek and is fenced in with a good wire. The cemetery in Miami County has been lost to the memory of most of the people in th town. A history of the county says "the first death in Jackson County Township was infant of Thomas & Mary Addington. It was buried in the Converse Cemetery the first cemetery of the township and laid out on the land of Thomas Bacon who located a home in the northeast corner of the township. Page 387 says, "Thomas Addington came as as 1842 settling upon the present site of Converse, where he made a good farm upon which he resided for a period of about 12 or 15 years. Mary Addington, father of Thomas Addington was an early settler south of Converse."

We may presume that any stone bearing a date before 1872 has been removed from another cemetery to this one. The location of this cemetery is in section #33 Richland Township of Grant County, Indiana. The land lies between two railroads, th Chesapeake and Ohio and the Pennsylvania. Taylor Creek flows north on the west boundary, the east line is a county road.

Added at a labor date: Mrs. Francis Reynolds of Converse writes too late to be included in this volu "This small cemetery on the east edge of town Converse, was called the Xenia Graveyard." She states that Shadrack Elliott was the first person buried there whic not agree with the Miami County History. According to the mortality schedule for 19 Shadrack Elliott died in 1860 of that year age 58 of black tongue. He was a farmer born in North Carolina. His wife Rachel was born Oct. 6, 1824 and died May 1882. He second husband was a man named Morris. Mrs. Reynolds adds that she had a baby sister to die in 1876 and it was buried in the Xenia Graveyard. The above was written by the DAR in the 1940's.

I worked in this cemetery in the summer of 1995. It's location is the east Converse just north of State Road # 29 on 177 N (old leg of St. Rd. # 18 or the Delo Pike as many still refer to it) and is bordered on the west by Taylor Creek and the County Rd. 800 W.

It is a very clean and well kept cemetery. I mapped it out in sections so I someone would be easier. Most of the early graves are in what I labeled as Section with a few others scattered about throughout Section B - C - D. The dates you see i Section A tells you many of this Section were relocated graves from other cemeteries and of some sections is 'Unknown' persons that I found did not have a last name stone and could not be identified in any other way.

I would like to include here an article that appeared in the "Converse Journ Indiana News - time Vol 65 - Number 48 Courier of Converse, Miami County Indiana November 3, 1948 CENSIMENTAL EDITOR." This paper includes old articles from Xenia newspapers, public records about 100 yrs. old and excerpts from the Miami Coun History. This particular piece most likely was from an old newspaper.

XENIA CEMETERY

"The first person buried in this cemetery was the infant child of Thomas and Mary Addington. It was the first death in Jackson Township, about 1846.

This cemetery was located on the land of Francis Davis. It was a rather big place which, of course, the pioneers always chose. It was 10 rods wide and 11 1/2 r long, and at present, the house of G.M. Reynolds occupies the site.

A large number of people were buried there until 1864, when the Friends, mad cemetery northwest of town.

In 1873, the Odd Fellows laid out the large cemetery east of town. After th first cemetery was no longer used.

This cemetery stood for years, covered with graveyard moss and in the summer high weeds. Large evergreens towered above everything until 1897, when Ben McDaniel cleared off everything and built a white brick house on the site.

In digging a cistern, he ran across two coffins which were made of walnut as solid as new timber."

The first list is people recorded by the DAR in the 1940's, that I did not l this time. I had no way of knowing where they were, originally, when the DAR read t cemetery, so I kept them separate. The rest is divided by drives that run through i lettered trees "A to O", to locate the section of the person or person's you seek.

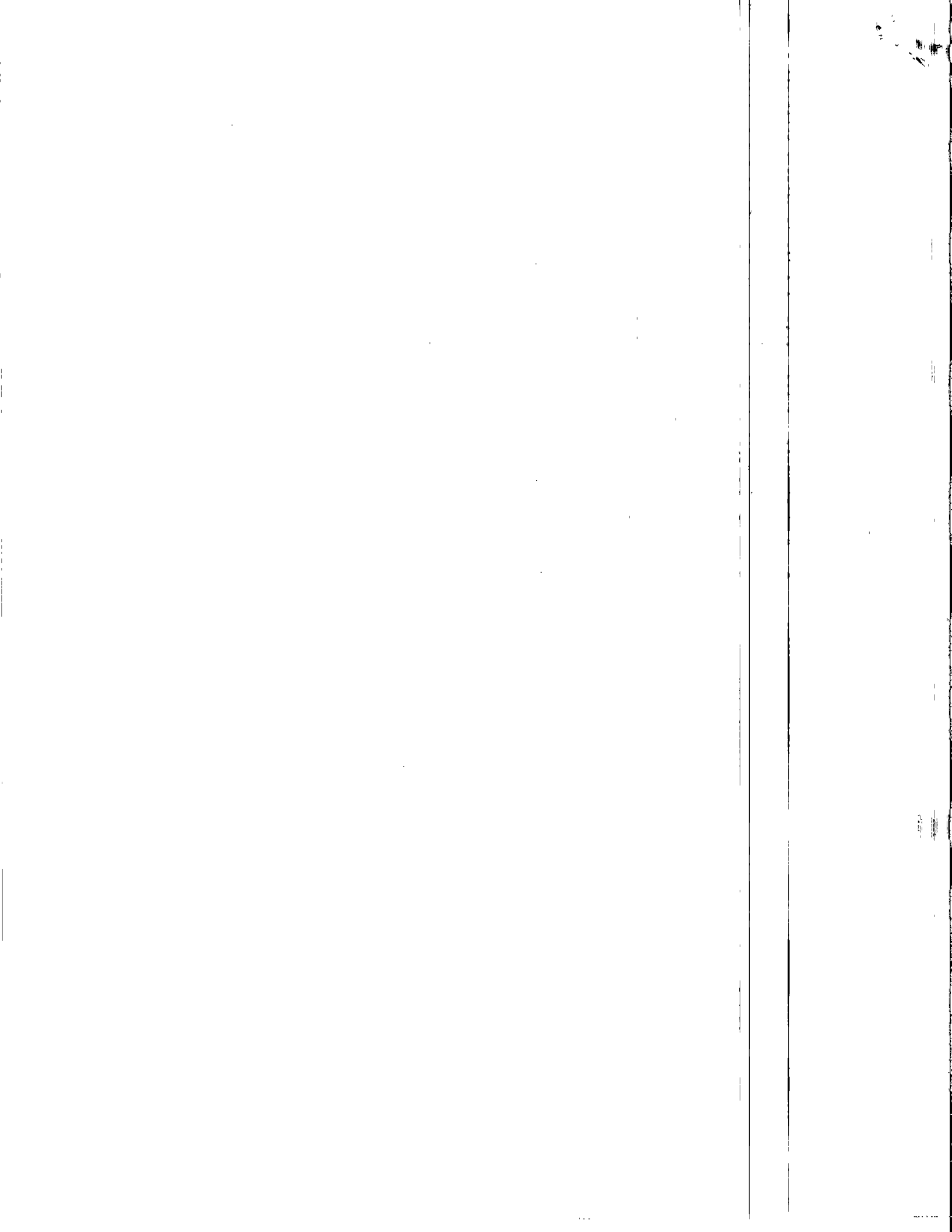

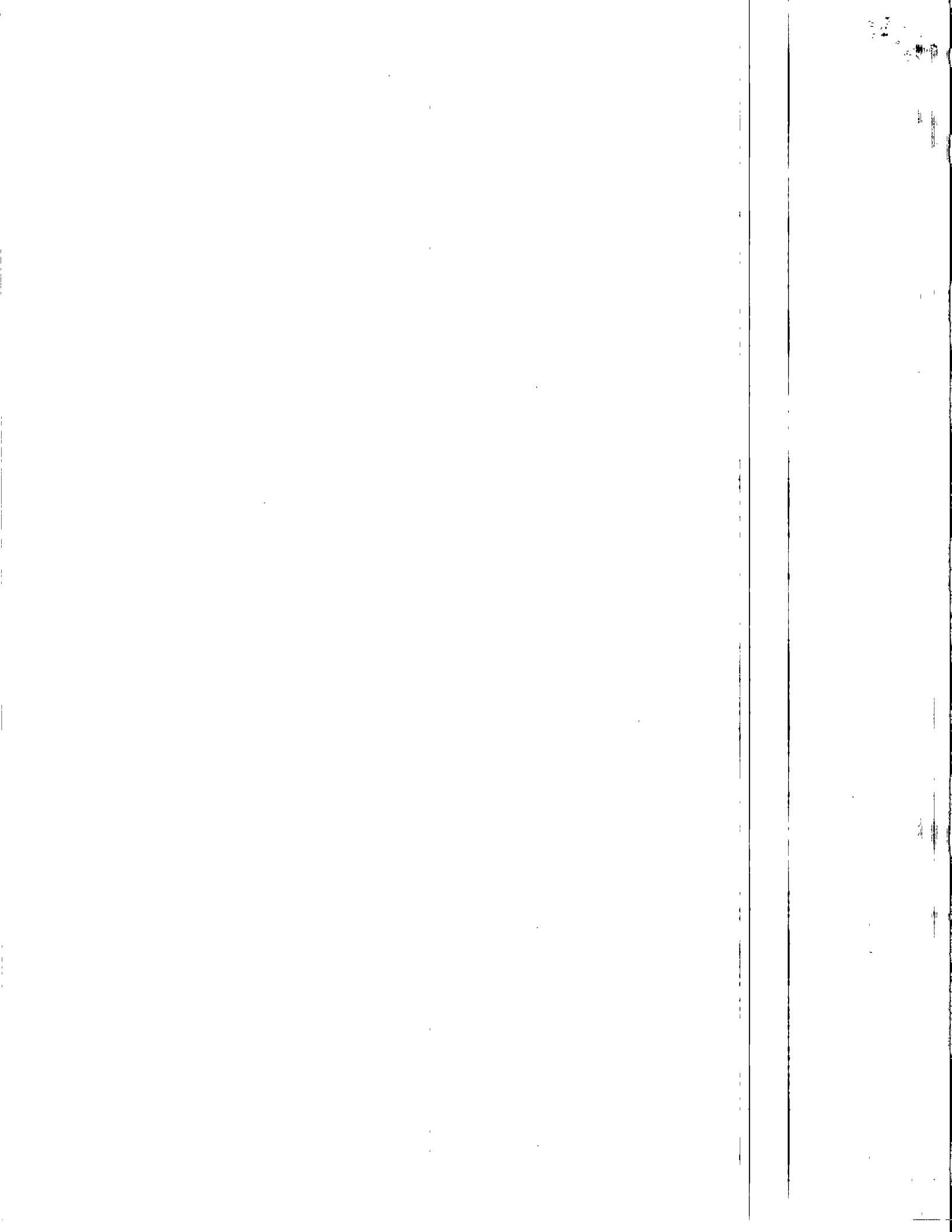

NORMAL/SLASH CEMETERY

Normal is a small village which has little to give it that name. A post - office was established there in 1852 under the name of Slash. This Government facility was permanently discontinued in 1902. A church of the Disciple denomination was erected and a small plot of ground set aside for burial purposes. The earliest burial was that of Indiana Smith Martha Beard who died Sept. 17, 1860. The latest date is Nov. 7, 1902. This cemetery is on State Road 13 four miles south of Swayzee, in Green Township Section 10.

This is what the DAR wrote in the 1940's.

In 1995 I read this cemetery. The oldest burial I found was Levina A. wife of John Lyons died Nov. 24, 1853 aged 38y.10m.21d. This predates the DAR reading by several years. The condition of this cemetery at the time of their reading is unknown by this writer. Chances are it wasn't in very good shape, as many of the old burial grounds were not kept up at that time. The last burial to take place in this cemetery was Charles Swan 1866 - 1943.

A church now known (1995) as the Normal Church of Christ is in front of this cemetery. It is located in the N.E. 1/4 of the N.E. 1/4 of Section 10 Township 23 N. Range 6 E. in the town of Normal on State Road #13, south of State Road #22 in Green Township on county road 600 S., about 1/10th of a mile west of State Road # 13. This is another one of the many abandoned cemeteries that are scattered around the countryside.

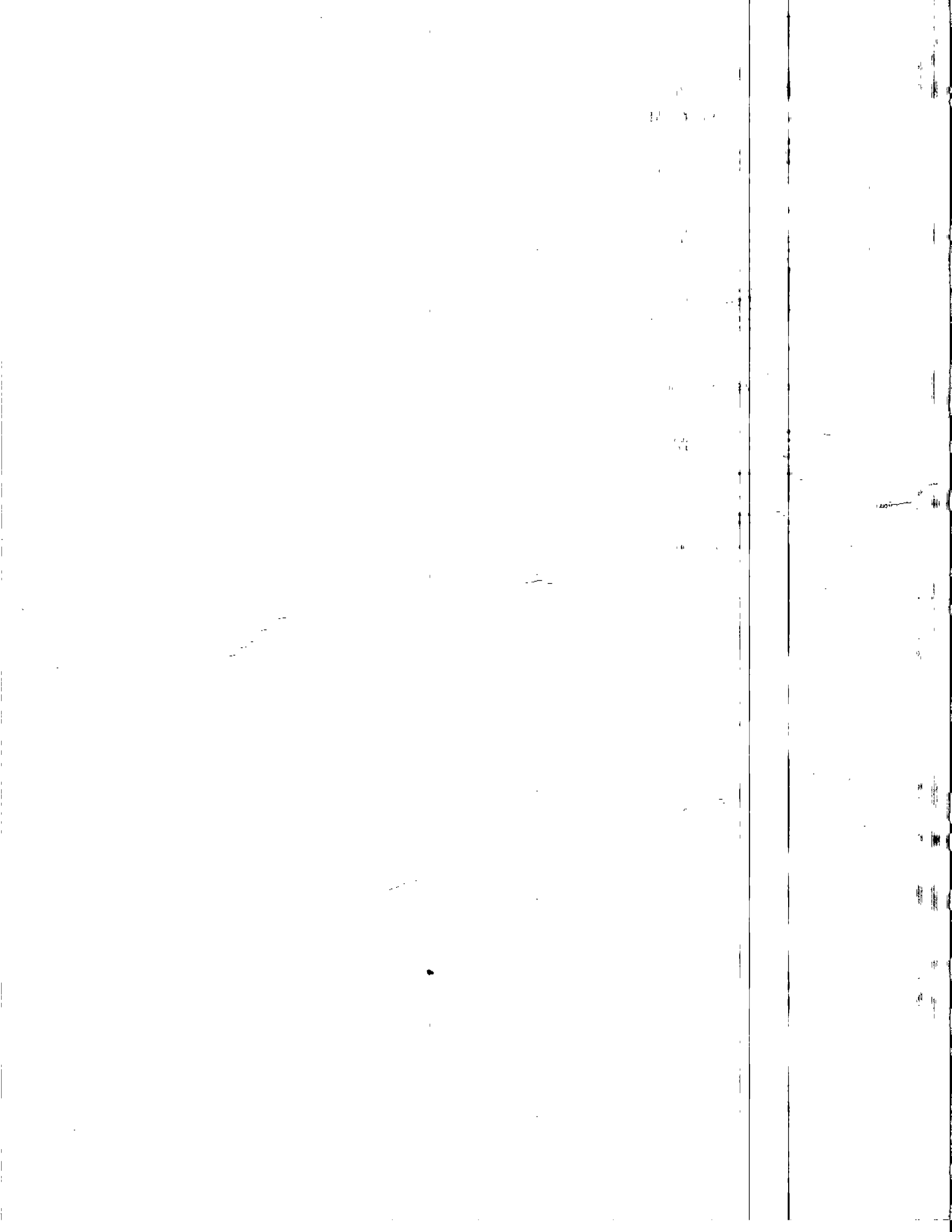

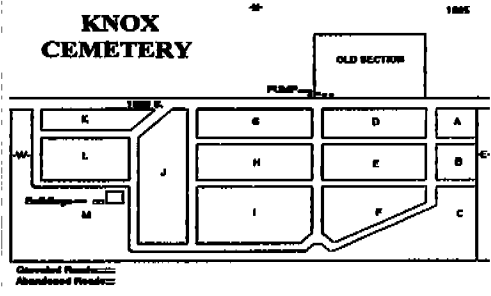

KNOX CHAPEL and (New) KNOX CEMETERY

The United Brethren denomination organized a church group here in 1855 and named it for John Knox who was a prominent member of the group. This is a small cemetery which lies to the east of the church building which is not used at the present time. Few burials are made in this part of the cemetery, nearly every one using the newer part across the road. There is a stockholders association which is responsible for the good care given these two plots. The earliest date on a stone is March 19, 1859.

These two cemeteries are noted through the county for their beauty. The old plot lies in section #26 of Green Township and the new part is just across the road in Section #35.

The above was written by the DAR in the 1940's.

I worked in this cemetery in the summer of 1996. This is one of the nicer cemeteries of the county. The easiest way to get to this cemetery is to go south of Marion on State Road 37 to 1000 South and turn right or west and proceed down 1000 S. past 700 West and within a half a mile you will see this cemetery on both sides of the road. The old church is now gone, torn down a couple of years ago. It hadn't been in use for the last 40 years. Vandalism and time had taken its toll and with the fear of someone getting hurt in it, and a heavy heart, the decision was made to tear it down. The corner post on both sides of the walk and the walk are still there as quiet reminders of the common country church, that could be found every few miles all over our county. Now only a few remain.

While working here I had the pleasure of meeting Mr. Max Leisure, the man who served this cemetery for 41 years and is still helping out. He talked to me a little bit about the changes that had occurred in his time.

He told me that when the new part of the cemetery was started it was originally called the "The New Knox Chapel Cemetery", but the New in the name was soon lost and now few people remember that it ever existed. Several years ago the old Knox Cemetery, the part that is in section #26 was put up for sale. He said he contacted a lawyer about the sale of a cemetery and was told it was perfectly legal, as they held the deed to the piece of land. They wanted \$1500.00 for it, but the cemetery board couldn't raise enough money to buy it. It appears the two cemeteries are still really separate, but most people don't realize it now.

He pointed to a piece of ground where very few stones were standing and told me that it really is full. During the depression, when they were using that area, people didn't have any money for headstones for their families. He told me about a man that was in World War I or II, by the last name of Jacoby. This man was buried without a stone. He said he tried to contact the daughter, to

no avail. This is really a shame as the government provides stones for all veterans, free of charge. It was a pleasure to talk to Mr. Leisure.

Following is part of an article, taken from the Chronicle Tribune of Oct. 3, 1995.

Leisure family has deep roots

"Point Isabel

- Max Leisure is following in his father's footsteps. And his grandfather's. And two of his uncles'. And a cousin's.

The Leisure name and membership to the Knox Cemetery board go hand in hand. Generation after generation has served on the board.

But Max Leisure's tie to the community does not end there. For more than 100 years, the Leisure family has helped the area grow. Max's grandfather even had a town named after him. At 76, Max Leisure has served as the secretary/treasurer for Knox Cemetery more than half of his life; 41 years. (Now semi-retired in 1996.) He's seen the cemetery, near Point Isabel, double in size and has helped out in every way, from digging graves to selling lots to mowing grass.

The cemetery was started in 1908. In 1916, Max Leisure's grandfather, Nathan J. Leisure, became president

of the cemetery board. Then Max's father, Orange Leisure, became general superintendent. Later, Orange's brother, Bert, served as president. And his brother, Oscar, was a board member. Oscar's son, Joseph, was on the board in the 1930's.

After the Civil War, Nathan Leisure moved to a town that was then called Harmony, south of Point Isabel, and became an active citizen in the tiny community. (This town is in Madison County, Indiana, just across the Grant and Madison county line. The town was later named Leisure in honor of Nathan Leisure, Max's grandfather.)

RANGE 6 EAST

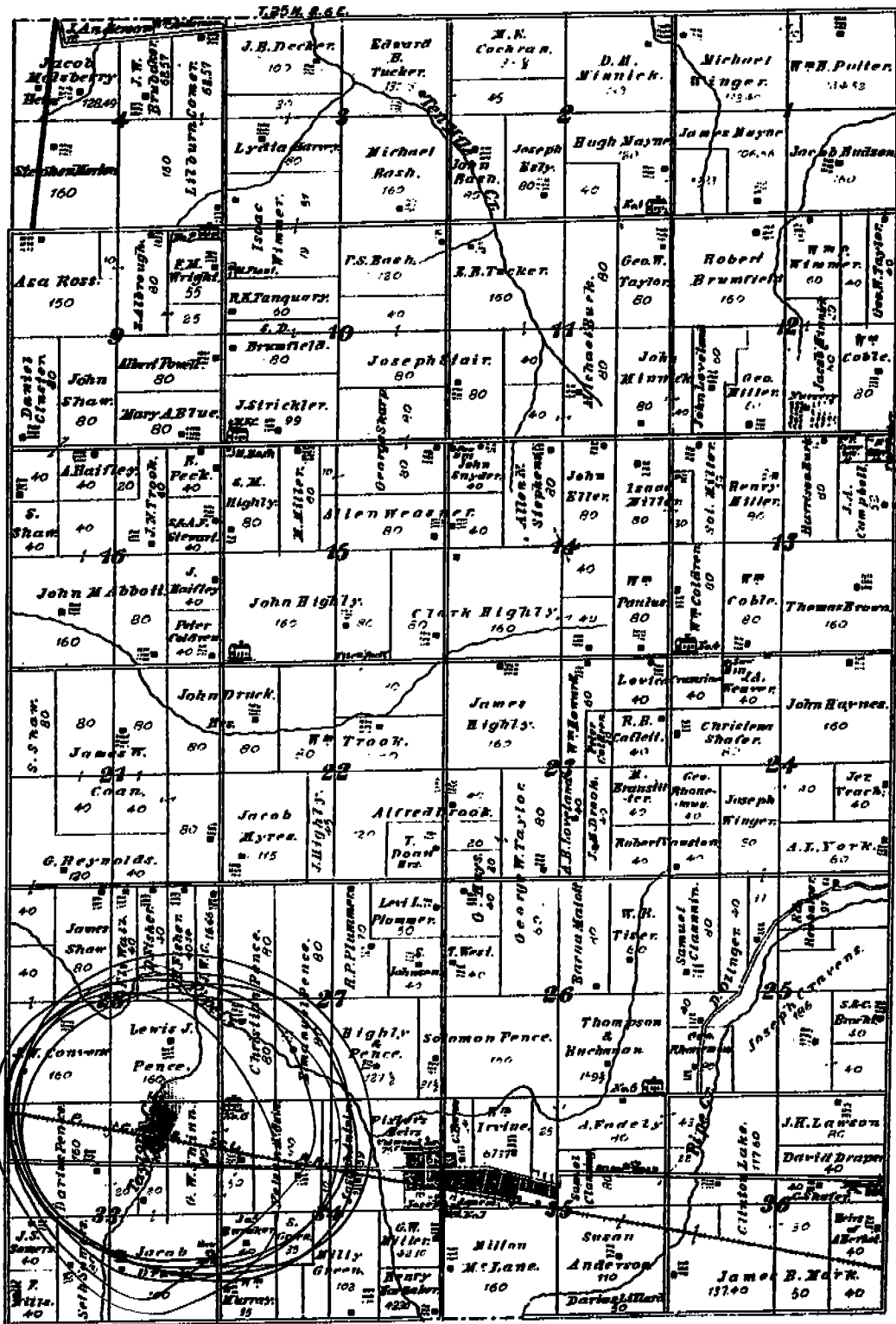


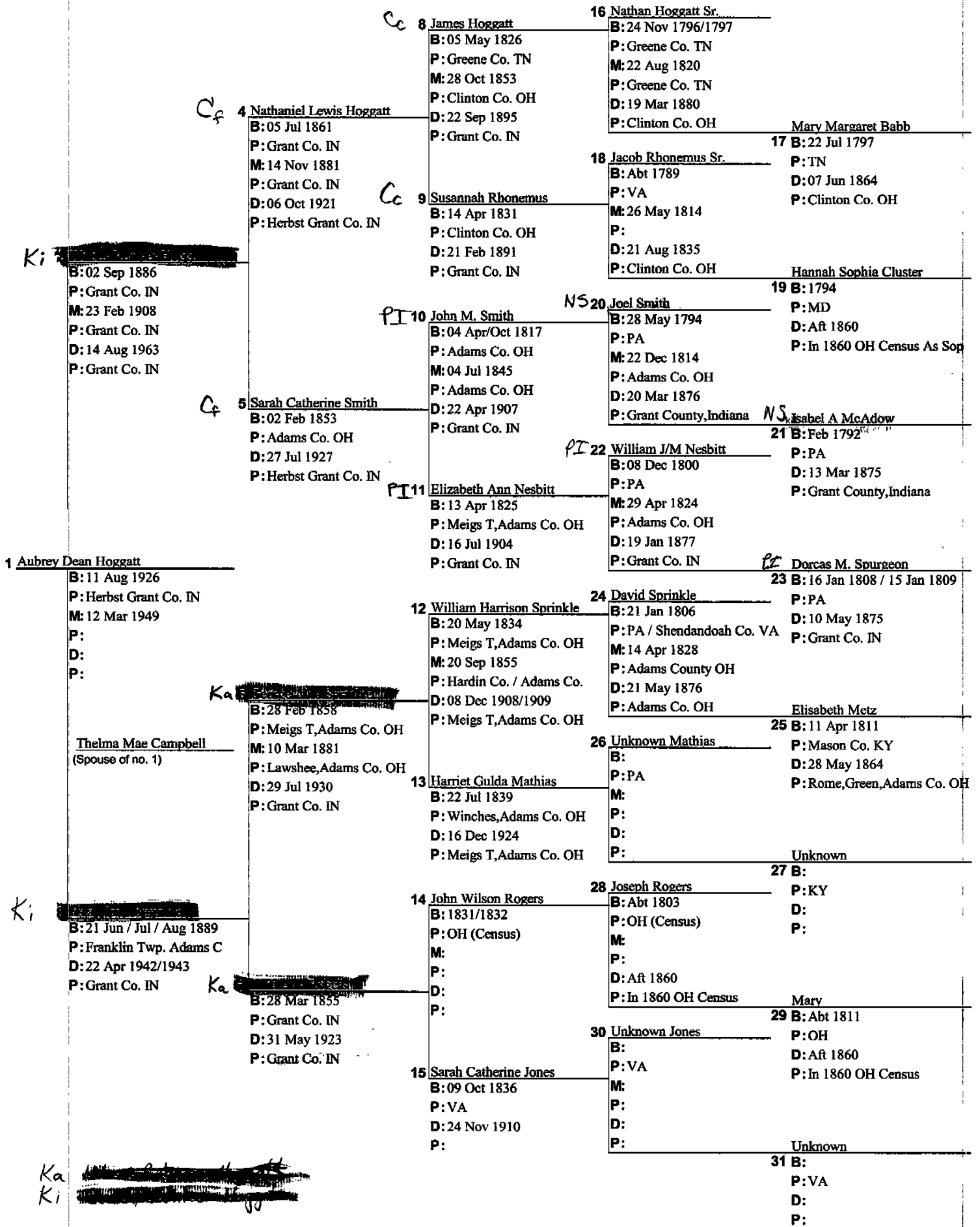
