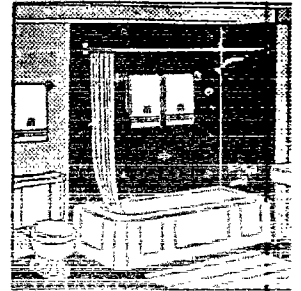
The Lord has been good to me and mine, and I hope that the remaining classmates of 1944 can say the same.
