Dear Tom,

I'm glad to hear you are going to send me a package because ~~I need some soap, either bars or flakes.~~ I went all over the mill looking for soap yesterday and they don't have anything but Castrol ~~Barquell~~ I will be glad to get any kind of bar or package soap. I hope it isn't as scarce in S. K. as it is here.

I was a little worried the other day when I counted my money - found out ~~I had \$3.00~~ I thought you gave me \$5 instead of \$3.

I have paid all the first room payment and most all of my books. I think I have to buy a biology book but my books cost about \$20 for room payment and \$5 for fees. I have \$2.00 left in the bank yet. I wrote a check for about \$16 worth of my book & supplies.

I had to pay \$2.25 for the 5 days a wk
 newspaper and \$5.00 for playshop
 things like that I paid for out of the
 cash. I am sending you a copy of the
 newspaper. Notice coal hours.

The food here is good and we can have
 two helpings if we like. I have been taking
 glasses of milk each meal in hopes of
 gaining weight.

I am glad to hear you might be able
 to come down with Milton & Dorothy. I don't
 imagine I can get you a ticket for the
 Indiana ^{+ Purdue} game because it is already
 sold out because it is the last & most
 important game of the year for both IU
