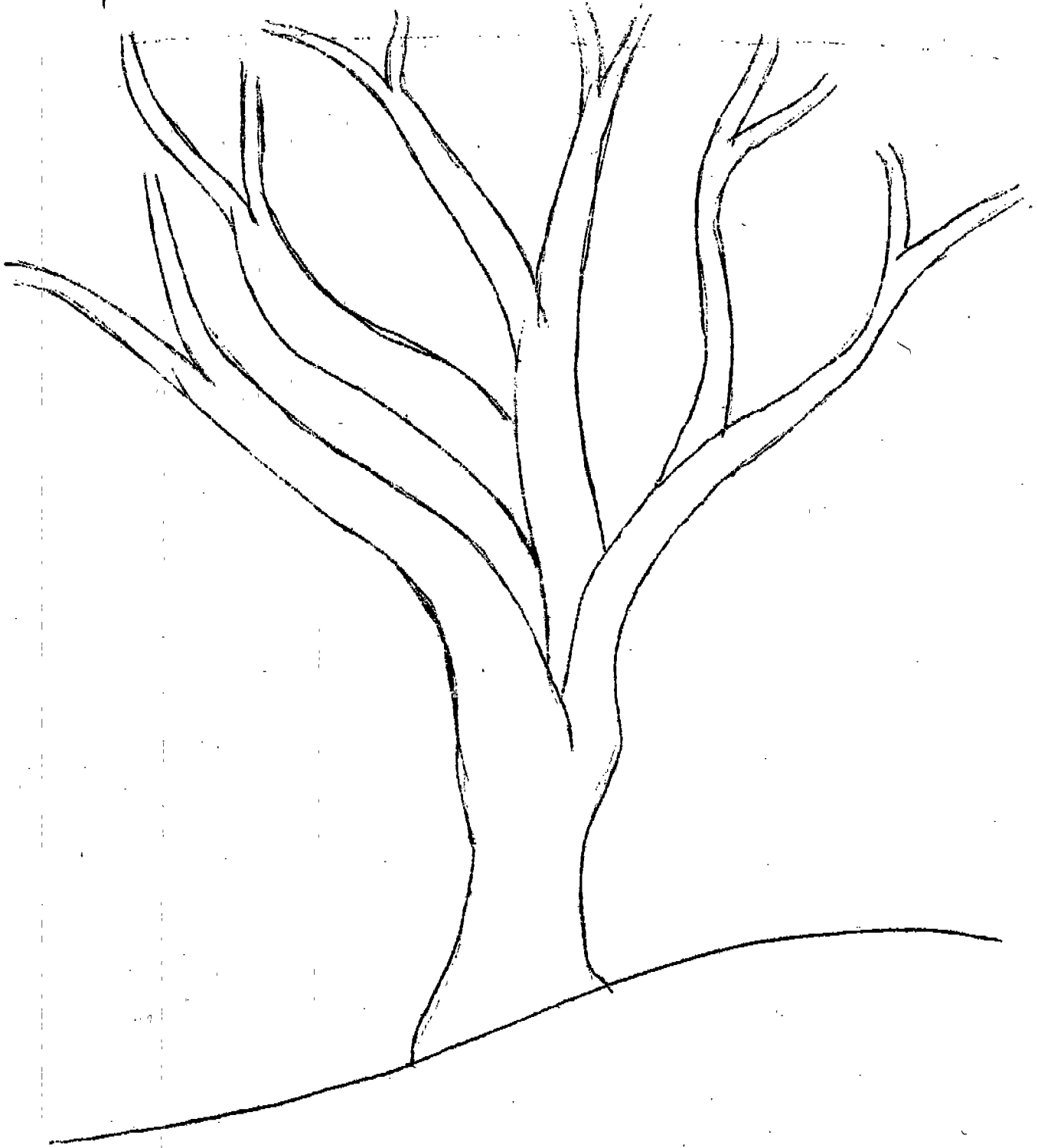

John M. Smith

A Venerable Pioneer

John M. Smith, a pioneer of Grant County, resided in the same house in Green Township where he took up his residence in 1856, until the time of his death. When he settled on this farm it was covered with a dense forest and much of it was called swamp land. This he cleared, drained and improved until it is now numbered among the better farms of Green Township.

John Smith was born in Adams County, Ohio, October 4, 1817. He was a son of Joel and Isabelle A. McAdow Smith, natives of Ohio and Maryland.

He learned the trade of bricklaying, which he followed in connection with farming for more than sixty years. Mr. and Mrs. Smith were earnest Christians, being members of the Church of Christ. He was elected assessor of his township and held that office for seven years. His career was an honorable one and well worthy of praise by his numerous descendants.

John M. Smith was born Oct. 4, 1817 in Adams County, Ohio, being the son of Joel and Isabelle "McAdow" Smith, natives of Ohio and Maryland, respectively.

On July 4, 1845 he was united in marriage with Elizabeth Ann, daughter of William and Dorcas "Spurgeon" Nesbitt.

His parents came from Holland, pitching their tent among the liberty loving people of Pennsylvania. From there they moved to Tennessee. He became the first Squire, doing all his writing with goose quills or wild turkey quills.

He married a lady by the name of Mary Babb and to this union were born eleven children. After raising their family and seeing all of them able to care for themselves, she became ill and died about the time of the beginning of the Civil War.
